

PRIVACY PROTECTION

Protecting your privacy and your personal data is an important aspect of the way we create, organize and implement our activities on-line and off-line. Our Web site follows the OECD principles set out in OECD report on digital privacy.



Privacy Protection

This policy establishes how we handle the information we learn about you when you visit the main Century Trust website (<http://www.centurytrust.com/>). Protecting the privacy and personal data of our visitors is of utmost importance to us. Protecting your privacy and your personal data is an important aspect of the way we create, organize and implement our activities on-line and off-line. Our Web site follows the OECD principles set out in OECD report on digital privacy.

The specific practices outlined in this privacy statement apply to the Century main web site (<http://www.centurytrust.com/>).

Purpose Specifications and Data Collection

In general, you can browse the Century Web site without disclosing any information about yourself. If you visit Century Web site to read or download information, we collect and store only the following information that is automatically recognised: the date and time, the originating IP address, the domain name, the type of browser and operating system used (if provided by the browser), the URL of the referring page (if provided by the browser), the object requested and the completion status of the request.

Cookies and Other Technologies

As described above, we sometimes collect anonymous information from visits to our website to help us provide better customer service. For example, we keep track of the domains from which people visit and we also measure visitor activity on the Century Web site, but we do so in ways that keep the information anonymous. We use the information that we collect to measure the number of visitors to the different areas of our website, and to help us make our website more useful to visitors. This includes analyzing these logs periodically to measure the traffic through our servers, the number of pages visited and the level of demand for pages and topics of interest. The logs may be preserved indefinitely and used at any time and in any way to prevent security breaches and to ensure the integrity of the data on our servers.

We collect the anonymous information we mentioned above through the use of various technologies, one of which is called "cookies". A cookie is an element of data that a website can send to your browser, which may then be stored on your hard drive. Cookies are used to save the visitor's username so that it does not have to be re-entered at each new visit. The following information is stored in the cookies:

- IP address
- Session number
- If an "account holder" of Century Trust returns to the site without logging in, the ID stored in the cookie are used to track the user (unless the user manually deleted the cookie, at which point the server will automatically regenerate another cookie).

Also, when we collect personal data from you in connection with a transaction we may extract some information about that transaction in an anonymous format and combine it with other anonymous information.

This anonymous information is used and analyzed only at an aggregate level to help us understand trends and patterns. None of this information is reviewed at an individual level. If you do not want your transaction details used in this manner, you can disable your cookies. We do not associate the information stored in a visitor's cookie with any other personal data about that visitor. All our employees and processors who have access to personal data and are associated with the processing of that data are obliged to respect the confidentiality of data.

Security

We intend to protect the quality and integrity of your personal information. Century LendInvest Ltd has implemented technologies and security policies to protect the stored personal data of our users from unauthorized access, improper use, alteration, unlawful or accidental destruction and accidental loss. We will continue to enhance our security procedures, as new technology becomes available. Century employees and processors who have access to personal data are obliged to respect the privacy of our visitors and the confidentiality of their personal data.
